COURSE DESCRIPTION

PCCA Institute's two-day, on-site Boot Camp introduces students to unique dosage forms, basic compounding techniques, legal and regulatory updates, and quality and safety aspects used by contemporary compounding pharmacists. Students are enlightened to the reality and feasibility of opening their own compounding pharmacy and inspired to think of compounding as a viable, rewarding and fulfilling career pathway.

Boot Camp students will make the following compounded dosage forms:

- Carbomer gel
- Methocel gel
- Foam cleanser
- PLO gel
- Lip balm
- Lollipops
- Rectal suppositories
- Troches
- Oral suspension
- Capsules (using the Jaansun® Capsule Machine)

Boot camp grads are eligible to complete PCCA Institute's Advanced and Veterinary Compounding Lab courses.
