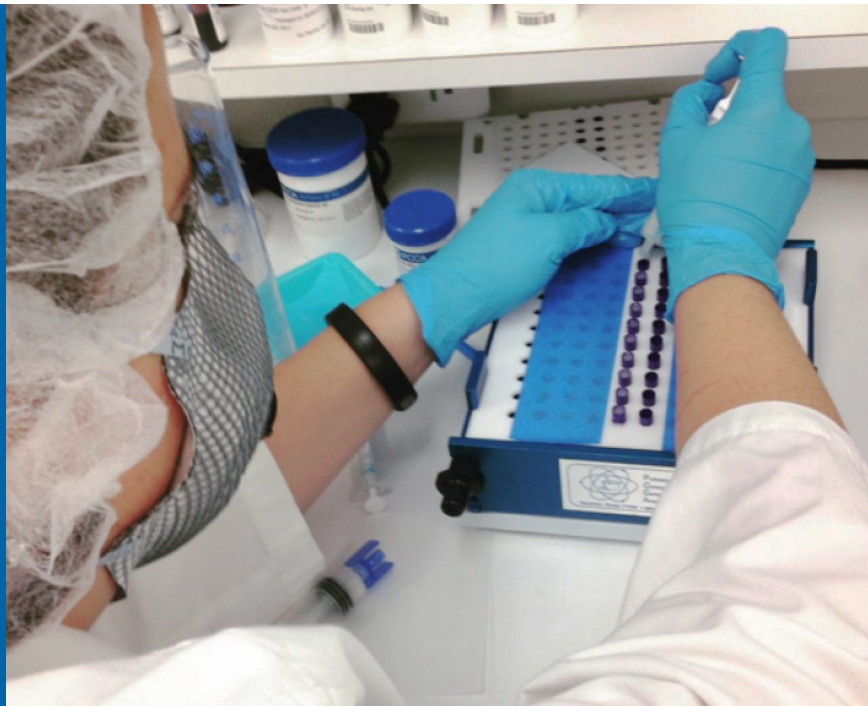


Advanced Compounding Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Online Course (10 weeks)

Teaches students:

- Various dosage forms and how to determine which are appropriate based on the patient's needs
- The interrelationships between the physical and chemical aspects of pharmaceutical compounding
- Regulatory guidelines currently governing this practice
- To work together to solve "real world" case studies
- How compounding can be a business opportunity

Laboratory Component (2 days)

The laboratory component is conducted at PCCA's facility in Houston, Texas and includes time in our lab compounding various non-sterile dosage forms such as tablet triturates, rapid dissolve tablets, and rectal rockets. There are also guest lectures on topics such as supplemental nutrition and third-party billing.
