How to Enter

Complete an online application that outlines the main ideas of your **10-minute stage presentation.** In 150 words or less, your bulleted outline should answer the following:

- » How will you be the pharmacist that changes our compounding pharmacy profession for the better?
- » Why do you want to go into compounding for your career?
- » In what areas of compounding are changes needed? Why?
- Submit a 2-minute video pitch previewing your presentation introduction

 what you'll actually say on-stage to grab the audience's attention. This should support the content you're submitting in your written application.
 Be sure to demonstrate your presentation skills and ability to engage with an audience, and don't forget to introduce yourself and where you attend pharmacy school.

Your application and video must be submitted at the same time. The best practice is to write and save your answers to the application questions in a separate document. Then, copy/paste your answers into the application when you are ready to submit your application and video.

Timeline

- Wednesday, August 31, 2022: Deadline to apply and submit video pitch by 11:59 p.m. CT.
- Week of September 5, 2022: Three finalists are notified.
- **Monday, September 26, 2022:** Each finalist delivers their 10-minute presentation virtually to the PCCA Judging Committee.
- Wednesday, September 28, 2022: Winner is notified.
- Week of October 10, 2022: Winner receives preparation guidance for their presentation at International Seminar.
- Wednesday, October 26, 2022: PCCA International Seminar 2022 begins in Houston, Texas.
- **Saturday, October 29, 2022:** Winner presents their vision for compounding pharmacy to 300+ pharmacists at International Seminar 2022.
